Important Answers to Questions About Hospice Care

WHAT is hospice?

Hospice is for patients with a life-limiting illness. **Hospice focuses on making a person's final journey comfortable, dignified and meaningful.**

Care teams can include everyone from doctors and nurses to social workers, physical therapists, chaplains, home health aides and volunteers.

Hospice focuses on relieving pain and other symptoms so that every day with family and friends is more rewarding.

Hospice pays for all medications, medical equipment such as a hospital bed, or oxygen and medical supplies related to the hospice diagnosis.

WHERE is hospice provided?

Care is provided wherever the patient calls home; a private home, an assisted living facility, board & care, or a skilled nursing facility.

WHEN is the right time for hospice?

When treatments shift from curing illness to providing comfort care, it may be time for hospice. The earlier services are started, the greater the benefits to patients and their loved ones. We often hear, "we only wish we had known about hospice sooner."

HOW much does hospice cost? Can we afford it?

In most cases, there is no cost to you. Hospice is covered 100% under Medicare and MediCal and most private insurance plans.

WHY choose VNAcare?

We respect each patient and family's choices and unique needs, and refuse to follow models that standardize care.

VNAcare has the expertise to manage a wide range of high acuity needs such as IV hydration, pain management pumps, complex wound care and more. We evaluate each patient's specific needs to determine how we can help.



Spiritual and Grief Support

We support the spiritual and emotional needs of patients and their families during hospice care and offer bereavement services for 13 months after the loss of a loved one to help survivors cope with their grief.



Social workers, chaplains, and counselors are key members of your VNAcare team; providing help on an individual basis and as part of our bereavement and support groups.
